

Message from the President

We are all aware of the saying, "The only thing that's constant, is change!" Needless to say, it applies to our upcoming 2025 season.

We will start with the biggest change—our draft conferences. After years of concerns from our members relative to player safety (due to field conditions) while participating in all three of our draft conferences at Roe Park (in Overland Park), and morethan-acceptable canceled games due to rainouts or even flooding from Indian Creek, the board decided it was time for us to make a "change". We were able to acquire access to all five turfed and fenced fields at the Frank White Sports Complex in Lee's Summit for the Monday and Thursday conferences, so we moved these two conferences there starting this sea-Due to younger players scheduling son. tournaments, almost every weekend at the Frank White complex, we were not able to move the Saturday draft confer-So, that conference will stay ence there. at Roe Park. See an additional article on this subject within this publication.

And we continue to hear concerns about our night-time games lasting too long (members getting home too late at night... at times). As many as nine different solutions have been suggested, with seven of them being tested...with little, or no help. We did "change" our competitive conference's flip-flop rule for 2025 (to match the draft) in an effort to help with this problem, but that does not apply to all games. A serious discussion on this topic occurred within the Rules Committee this past month (January), relative to keeping the 1-1 starting count on the batter, but going to "no courtesy foul" rule. But that did not pass. So, our search to save time on our games continues.

But there is one constant that has NOT seemed to have changed over the years,

"Let's play ball!"

And with repeated requests for KC Metro to again have a conference venue "north of the river" (after having left the area about 8 years ago), we are attempting to make our presence felt there again—with the start of a 35+ Mixed Hybrid Draft conference on Wednesday nights at Happy Rock Park - 7565 NE Antioch Rd., Gladstone, MO 64119. There is a moredetailed description of this topic in an article included in this publication..

We will, again, have "change", hopefully for the betterment of the organization, to some of our rules. The application of our equalizer runs to be given or received, for our competitive conferences, has been "changed" to a run-differential scale—opposed to it being based on hard -fast team ratings. Teams will still be numerically rated, but determining the equalizers will be on a sliding scale.

A team's rating will now be based on the top 12 players on a team's roster opposed to the top 10 over the past number of years.



You may recall at our annual meeting, I enthusiastically announced that we were going to 'capitalize' the cost of our massive softball purchase—because what says financial responsibility like turning softballs into assets? It sounded very official, didn't it? Well, after further research (and a few sleepless nights reading IRS regulations that are just as thrilling as watching paint dry), I discovered that capitalizing those softballs would require filing a change in our accounting method with the IRS. And, frankly, the only thing worse than a pop fly to the face is extra paperwork with the IRS. So, to keep things simple and avoid the govern-




ment's version of a 12-inning game, I've decided to keep our accounting 'soft'—just like the balls themselves.

As a result, the numbers I'm reporting now don't match what I gleefully shared at the annual meeting. Let's just say I've learned that while softballs are a hit on the field, they're not the right kind of asset in the accounting world. You can rest assured that this decision was made to save us time, effort, and perhaps a few aspirins.


Your league remains in a solid and improving financial position. We have also added some additional volunteer muscle to our finance team. Denny Williams has agreed to take on the role of Assistant Treasurer. Bob Dona and Jim Glynn have agreed to join Ray Harre on our Finance Committee.


We ended the year with *Net Assets* of \$52,902. *Net Assets* are the amount by which our total assets exceed our total liabilities. *Net Assets* are what we, in our personal lives, would call our net worth.

As shown in the following graph, we have steadily built back our *Net Assets* from the low points reached during the 2020 and 2021 COVID years. The board of directors monitors the Net Assets to ensure our ongoing financial stability.



The following summarizes the recent Total Organization's annual *Excess (Gain) or Deficit (Loss) in Revenues Over Expenses*. A negative number (shown to the left of the center) means the expenses exceeded revenues in that particular year.





The 2024 Total Organization excess revenue over expenses of \$5,823 is allocated between our four operating funds - General Operations, Competitive Conferences, Draft Conferences, and Contingency Funds (Fund Raising and Unrestricted Sponsorships).

General Operations revenue consists of our membership dues and is offset by our General Operations expenses (those not directly related to the Competitive and Draft conferences or Contingency Funds).

During 2023, we established a financial goal to have the General Operations, Competitive, and Draft conferences operate each year at or near break-even. We also set a financial goal to build our Contingency Fund through fundraising and unrestricted sponsorships to cover periodic extraordinary events or expenses.

The chart above shows that our 2024 General Operations resulted in a \$3,675 deficit due in part to the large softball purchase. The Competitive Conferences came in with a \$3,628 excess primarily due to some budgeted games not being played at the end of the season. These excess funds will be used in 2025. The draft conferences generated a small \$607 deficit due to some unbudgeted expenses in connection with the open house we held at the Frank White Softball complex. Primarily due to the net gain from the Wes Weddle Classic tournament and an unrestricted sponsorship, we were able to add \$6,477 to our Contingency Fund in 2024.



A look at the Men's Draft Conferences 2024 and 2025







2024 was a banner year for the KCMSSL's Draft Conferences with 4 conferences across the Metro fielding a total of 23 teams and a total of 269 players.

And 2025 looks to be an even bigger year with a new 35+ Mixed Hybrid Conference slated to launch on Wednesday evening North-of-the-river at Happy Rock Park (7565 NE Antioch Rd., Gladstone, MO 64119 <u>https://</u> maps.app.goo.gl/fRKXVy2utCdzCHrv7). If this conference takes off it will bring the KCMSSL's draft conference total to 5

35+ Mixed Hybrid Conference (Wed PM) at Happy Rock Park in Gladstone, Mo

50+ Conference (Tuesday PM) at the Independence Athletic Complex in Independence, Mo

60+ Conference (Thursday AM) at Frank White Sports Complex in Lee's Summit, MO)

60+ Conference (Saturday AM) at Roe Park in Overland Park, KS)

70+ Conference (Monday AM) at Frank White Sports Complex in Lee's Summit, Mo.

You are all probably aware of how our standard, long-time draft conferences work but you may ask what in the world is a Mixed Hybrid Conference? Draft Commish. Barry Gordon In order to get this conference up and running, the KCMSSL has decided to get creative in that we only have a limited number of members who live north of the river. With that said, we are opening this draft to anyone—male or female who is 35+. The mixed hybrid part is defined and configured as:

Mixed simply means for both men and women. Not co-ed, where there is a predetermined number of men and women in the line-up. But mixed, where there could be any combination of, but the same number of, men and women on each team (i.e., 8/2, 6/4, 4/6, etc.), with every player playing a minimum number of innings on defense, etc.

Hybrid means this will not be a fullblown draft conference. Hybrid allows a group of "no more than 5 players" to come in as a single entity and stay together as the nucleus for one of the participating teams. The remainder of each team is then filled in with individually drafted players via the standard draft process from the remaining player pool. As already implied, <u>it is our intent to balance out each of these 4 teams (as best</u> <u>as possible) by age, skill, gender, etc.</u>

This conference is not limited to just our members who live north of the river. All KCMSSL members are welcome to play in this conference.

Draft Overview, Continued

This is a departure from our normal draft conference set-up, but a portion of this format was used when we started our 70+ Monday morning draft conference a few years ago. It started as a modest 4 teams with the 5-player team nucleus and has evolved into a strong 7-team, 100+ member conference.

Kim Nordike (<u>knordike25@yahoo.com</u>, 816-213-6343) has agreed to take on the role of coordinator for this conference and will be your main contact for any questions or further information.

Initially we are looking at the following (which is subject to slight change if needed / requested): Start date of Wednesday - April 23rd @ 7:00 & 8:00 PM; ONE 14 Week Session / 28 games + a possible additional week(s) of Playoffs; Two Weekly 7-Inning Games + Playoffs (to be determined). Cost for this full year conference will be \$114.00 per player or \$3.80 per game. This has to be the cheapest form of entertainment to be found anywhere in the Metro!

Please note that in most of your 2session conferences, you

individually pay anywhere between \$50 and \$70.00 per session. If you double that, our \$114 conference cost is equal to, or less



than, the other conferences. Kim Nordike Wednesday Hybrid Draft coord. **MONDAY 70+ CONFERENCE** 2024-2025 (Frank White Lee's Summit) In 2024 weather tested the resilience of the Monday 70+ Draft players. Every game scheduled in May was rained out, one rain in July was so strong that it flooded the fields and wiped out consecutive game dates. Heat limited us to a single game one Monday.

One team lost enough players to injury that our 7-team league became a 6-team league after the first 7 weeks of play, and a steady increase of pool players the second session created a bit more chaos for coordinators, managers, and players. Ultimately, everyone adapted and persevered until a 3-way tie for the championship was broken by Steve Odegard and Greg Boyle's Purple gang.

<u>2025 Venue:</u> We're moving to the Frank White Complex at 3901 SW Longview Park Drive, Lee's Summit, near Longview Lake and the Fred Arbanas Golf Course. 

Originally, the conference played at Cottonwood Park in Lenexa, but after the park closed, it was moved to Black Bob Park in Olathe. 
With the 7 teams, we have a bye week every 6 weeks, for we play a 9-inning game and playing two games back



PAYING YOUR MEMBERSHIP DUES OR DRAFT CONFERENCE FEES

As of the writing of this article 374 members have already paid their 2025 dues, with many of them paying their draft conference fee(s) at the same time.

Paying dues or fees via League Sheets is a secure and encrypted process, similar to any other purchase you may complete via an "https' address website. No one within the KCMSSL other than you have access to your credit or debit card information as a result of this procedure. Our online payment process is easy and convenient. It eliminates the

handling of checks or cash by all parties, which subsequently eliminates the need for us to access your database record to manually mark your dues as "paid'.

Simply click on the "Online Player Registration" LINK at the very bottom of our website's home page https://kcseniorsoftball.org/, or the yellow "Online Player Registration softball ICON towards the upper right of this same webpage, and follow the steps.

Can't access your online record? Request a password reset by clicking on the "Reset it" button directly below your password entry window. NOTE: Look for your password reset link email to show up in your Spam, or Junk Mail folder. Additionally, note that the password reset links you are provided in these emails are recycled ones and have a shelf life. So, if the first link you receive does not work for you, please try again. Still having problems? Get in touch with Clint Berger - 913.481.7937.

Once you have accessed your record, update any outdated personal information on it, AND make sure you create and-SAVE a password for your record, or update the current one you think you have on file, so you can hopefully access your record next time without having to go through this "reset" process again. You are not allowed to alter your record's birthdate. If it is incorrect, simply e-mail our current Membership Secretary. Mark Kenney - mkenneyedfirst@gmail.com or Clint Berger at clintberger@hotmail.com , so they can update it for you.

If you've completed your updates and paid your dues or fees. you're done. A payment confirmation email should be on its way to you. Again, your confirmation email may end up in your Junk Mail or Spam folder. Once your dues are paid, your manager will then be able to add you to his or her team's official online roster.

Please note that DRAFT conference team rosters are NOT finalized until "around" the end of March (when the actual draft process for each conference is completed). Therefore, even though we ask that you be patient relative to knowing what team you are on this season (in each conference), we do suggest you get in touch with your conference coordinator if your draft conference manager does not contact you by the 2nd week of April.

If you are a KCMSSL Lifetime Member (i.e., you have made a minimum of one KCMSSL dues payment at age 75 or older), your online record will show a \$0.00 amount due for your membership dues. Click on the blue-shaded "Register for 2025 Spring" button on your record so we can account for you playing the current season AND so each of your manager(s) can add you to their team's online roster. If you wish to pay for any draft conference fees at the same time, "check" each appropriate conference listing box's \$\$ amount. The system will total your selections, along with the corresponding online convenience fee amount, and provide you with an overall total amount to pay. Then click the "Pay now by credit card button. Once the pop-up payment box appears, enter your card number, its month and year expiration, the 3-digit security code (i.e., CVC), and click the "Pay $$__"$

2025 Rule Changes Ann Willkett, Chairperson Rules Committee



Before you know it, it will be time to "PLAY BALL". With that comes additions and changes to our existing rules. Please remember we have rules to be sure we keep things even and fair for ALL players and teams. Here is a brief overview of the additions and changes for this year. This is not all the changes, so be sure to check out the rule book for this year. New changes and rules will be italicized and bold.

1 – The first change is a more clearly defined definition and explanation of the exceptions to the rule of the runner from home not being able to advance to second. The runner can advance to second if a ball is thrown out of play (ie: in the dugout or over the fence). Other advances could be possible while following each venue's ground rules (ie: Roe Park)

2 – Flip Flop Rule – The Flip Flop Rule for Competitive and Draft will now be the same. If the home team trails by at least seven runs, the original home team will bat first...... Here is where the change comes into play. If the visiting team begins the unlimited inning and is not ahead by 7 runs, if/when they are ahead by 10 runs, the flip flop will occur. Managers and umpires _{shall note} any runners on base, and the current batter, in case the home team ties or take the lead.... Previously the runs needed were 15 in competitive and 10 in draft. This year they will both be 10 runs.

3 – KCMSSL will not be using the "Batting Position" rule that SSUSA adopted last year. BATTING POSITION: The batter must take an initial position with his back foot no further forward than a line defining the front edge of home plate. The batter will be called out if he hits the ball when the back foot is completely further forward than the line defining the front edge of the plate.

We will revert back to our rule: The batter must have at least some portions of both feet on or inside the lines of the batter's box at the start of the pitch. A batter who steps out of the batter's box at any time during the pitch and then hits the ball, fair or foul, shall be called out. "Steps out of the batter's box" means one or both feet, totally, touching the ground outside of the lines of the batter's box.

4 – KCMSSL will allow bat warmers to be permitted in all conferences. There are other rules and definitions that have been modified and better defined. Please see those in the new rule book. *Any changes will be italicized and in bold print.*


